**RE: COMPANY REFERENCE – NEO INFRASTRUCTURE**

As part of the Middleton Beach Coastal and Adaptation Strategy the City of Albany contracted Neo Infrastructure to construct two 50m long trial Geotextile Sand Container groynes. The works included the filling and placement of 2.5m<sup>3</sup> Geotextile Sand Containers, including significant temporary works in the form of a sand coffer dam. The groynes will be used to monitor how sand moves and is trapped. This will assist in gathering data to inform the long term solution for this area of coast.

Significant time constraints including availability of the J-bins, and impending onerous weather conditions found the need for Neo to mobilise ahead of schedule, and complete the works in a smaller time frame than outlined in the contract. I am pleased to articulate that Mike and his team were extremely proactive in facilitating the construction within these tight deadlines.
